Scholars from different disciplines are welcome to share their contributions on a range of topics related to African linguistics, literary studies, history and anthropology. The language of the conference is English.

- Linguistic structures and usage patterns
- Discourse and communication, including new media
- Cultural keywords and values
- Grammaticalization processes

- Various literary genres, including proverbs and riddles
- Translation and second language teaching
- Cultural anthropology
- Postcolonial studies

Accepted papers will be allocated a 30-minute time slot: 20 minutes for the presentation and 10 minutes for discussion.
